Personal-injury lawyer lists condo for \$5.5 million

A Chicago personal-injury lawyer and his wife listed a high-floor condo off Michigan Avenue for \$5.5 million.

Louis Cairo, [a partner at Goldberg Weisman Cairo](#), and Gloria Cairo put the unit on the market today, listed with Chezi Rafaeli of Coldwell Banker.

The 5,100-square-foot full-floor unit is on the 48th floor of 21 E. Huron, a 49-story building also known as the Pinnacle.

One condo in the Pinnacle has sold for a higher price. In 2013, a unit with 6,000 square feet of space on the 45th floor went for \$6.5 million.

The Cairos bought the condo for \$3.6 million in December 2014, according to the Cook County Recorder of Deeds. They then "completely remodeled the whole place," Rafaeli said. He declined to list specifics of the rehab.

The couple plan to buy a larger house in the city where they can entertain their grandchildren, Louis Cairo said in a message passed

along by Rafaeli.

The condo has 360-degree views, Rafaeli said. The listing includes no interior photos, but a floor plan shows that the home has four bedrooms and four full baths, a media room and balconies on two of its four sides.

The pair also have [a home in South Barrington for sale](#) at just under \$3.2 million. That is nearly 10 percent below the \$3.51 million they paid for the 11,300-square-foot home on Brooke Lane in 2008, according to the Recorder.

The couple's South Barrington house was first listed for just under \$4 million in December 2014, around the same time they bought the downtown condo.
