## Casino CEO sells Huron Street condo

The head of the Majestic Star Casino in Gary, Ind., sold a two-bedroom condominium on Huron Street for \$1.06 million.

The 19th-floor unit at the Pinnacle has a formal dining room, floor-to-ceiling windows, extensive custom millwork and “spectacular views day or night,” [according to the listing](#).

Seller Peter M. Liguori listed the condo last August for just under \$1.25 million. He cut the asking price to \$1.1 million in February.

Liguori paid \$779,000 for the condominium in November 2004, according to the Cook County Recorder of Deeds. At the time, he was an executive with Hyatt Gaming Management, based in Chicago.

The sale, to buyers who are not yet identified in public records, closed May 1, according to information filed with the multiple-listing service by listing agent Chezi Rafaeli of Coldwell Banker.

Liguori could not be reached, and Rafaeli declined to comment.
